Whereas, starting on 5 February 2010 at approximately 1300 until 6 February 2010 at approximately 1300 Columbiana County received in excess of twenty (20) inches of snow. The heaviest activity occurred between 2100 and 0500 with snow accumulation totals of 2 inches per hour being reported. As a result of this activity, county and local governments have incurred substantial increases in operational costs in the areas of snow and debris removal. Based on National Weather Service records in the history of the county, this activity is the 4st greatest to snow accumulation since the 1800's. As a result of this storm over 10,000 county residents were affected by electrical power outages for extended periods of time. As of 8 February 2010 there are still nearly 1000 county residents without electrical service. Emergency shelters were activated to assist the residents located in the southern part of the county.
