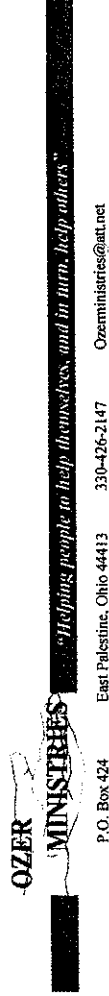

Commissioner Halleck stated he has received correspondence regarding sanctuary cities referring to the Second Amendment. The Board of Commissioners has no statutory requirements but might entertain the passage of a Resolution. He will travel to Columbus this week and gather more information to discuss at the next meeting.

Commissioner Weigle gave an update on the Recorders books that were moved to storage some time ago. The facility was to be climate controlled but did not appear to be as the books became moldy and needed to be remediated. He found a company in Dover, Farsight Management, to come and clean the books. To date 500 books have been cleaned and moved to a secure, climate-controlled location in the Board of Elections basement. Commissioner Hoppel stated that is a huge job to correct. Commissioner Weigle stated it is very labor intensive. He hopes to have all the books moved by the end of next week. The decision of the final resting place for the books will be up to the Recorder that is elected in November. Jim Armeni, in attendance, asked where the books were stored. Commissioner Weigle stated they were stored at Great Value on Southern Boulevard. Jim Armeni then stated that is out of the county. Commissioner Hoppel stated this problem has been created by the now recorder and Tim has taken the lead to get the books under control. Commissioner Weigle stated when he went to the storage units that there was a new lock on them because the bill was not paid and the contents (books) were going to be put up for sale. This has also been taken care of and our new locks are now on the units.
