Commissioner Halleck updated the Board on the progress of the work on the jail renovation stating the showers and toilets have been completed and the flooring is expected to be done by the end of March.

Commissioner Weigle informed the Board that Chris Thomas of Spectrum has been in contact with him with respect to servicing the County with internet with a build time of 6-7 years, breaking ground in 2022. They will be able to serve up to 4000 homes, with 20 homes per mile bridging the gap with the federal program. Spectrum will be hiring at \$20.00 per hour for office and field work.

Commissioner Halleck stated it is good to have options to get hooked up to internet, although RAA is still available.

Commissioner Weigle said it is good to have another provider with good competition.

RESOLUTION NO. 14-2021

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF COLUMBIANA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND ENTER INTO A WATER POLLUTION CONTROL LOAN FUND ACCOUNT AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF COLUMBIANA COUNTY, OHIO, FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE HANOVERTON SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM AND DESIGNATING A DEDICATED REPAYMENT SOURCE FOR THE LOAN:

Whereas, Columbiana County, Ohio, seeks to construct a sanitary sewer collection in the Village of Hanoverton and expansion of the Kensington wastewater treatment plant to treat wastewater from Hanoverton; and

Whereas, Columbiana County, intends to apply to the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) for the construction of the above sanitary sewer system; and

Whereas, the Ohio Water Pollution Control Loan Fund requires the government authority to pass legislation for application of a loan and execution of an agreement as well as designating a dedicated repayment source; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of the Columbiana County Commissioners, Columbiana County, Ohio:

SECTION 1. The President of the Board, be and is hereby authorized to apply for a WPCLF loan, sign all documents for and enter a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority for construction of the sanitary sewer improvement project.

SECTION 2. That the dedicated source of repayment will be sewer user fees.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
