A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 21-2013 ESTABLISHING DOG REGISTRATION AND KENNEL FEES FOR COLUMBIANA COUNTY.

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2013, the Columbiana County Board of Commissioners ("Board") adopted Resolution No. 21-2013, establishing dog registration and kennel fees for Columbiana County, effective December 1, 2013; and

WHEREAS, this Board now desires to amend Resolution No. 21-2013 for the purpose of increasing dog and kennel registration fees in the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Columbiana County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Board, having estimated that the fees established in this Resolution are needed to pay all expenses for the administration of Chapter 955 of the Revised Code and to pay claims allowed for animals injured or destroyed by dogs, hereby establishes the following dog registration and kennel fees for Columbiana County:

Registration Period	Fee
1 year registration	\$12.00
3 year registration	\$36.00
Permanent registration	\$120.00
Kennel fee	\$50.00 for up to 5 tags (additional tags shall be \$1.00 per tag)

Section 2. The dog registration and kennel fees established herein shall be effective on December 1, 2021.

Section 3. Resolution No. 21-2013 is hereby repealed.

Section 4. The Clerk of this Board shall deliver copies of this Resolution to the Columbiana County Auditor and the Columbiana County Dog Warden.
