RE: PUBLIC HEARING – REGULAR ANNEXATION – PETITIONERS RICHARD & THERESA SPACK

Commissioner Papanodis addressed the individuals who signed in wishing to give testimony for or against the annexation into the City of Salem.

Attorney Ian Robinson, representing the Petitioners Richard & Theresa Spack spoke and presented a map showing the proposed annexation touches other properties that are already in the City of Salem. They need the annexation for the water and sewer, police and fire departments and ask to grant the annexation.

Mr. Jim Armeni, Perry Township Trustee, spoke in opposition of the annexation, stating the concern it could possibly create an island of the properties. He voiced this property would be serviced by the same fire and police departments as it is currently and the roads will still be maintained by the county. He advised the township and city are in discussions regarding water and sewer. When asked of the petitioners their reason for the request, they stated they need the water and sewer for the back side of their property.

Commissioner Papanodis stated the information presented would be taken under advisement before a decision is made.

Being no further business Commissioner Papanodis adjourned the Commissioners regular meeting.
