She stated they were awarded \$351,000 in grant money and they have served over 1000 senior residents in Columbiana County with either food, housing and/or digital assistance, exhausting all the monies and will be closing that account.

Ms. Ketterman presents information on the upcoming press release for the new Northeast Treatment Foster Home Program. She stated as a collaborative effort with Medina and Portage Counties, they have been approved by the state to start this pilot program. The goal of the Treatment Foster Care Program is for youth requiring out-of-home care to remain in or near their community for specialized assistance.
