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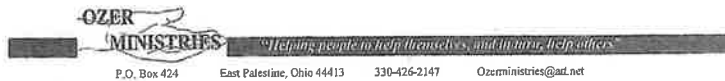

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## RE: FIBER OPTIC LINE REQUIREMENTS – COUNTY ENGINEER

Motion by Mr. Paparodis, seconded by Mr. Ginter to; approve the minimum Fiber Optic Line Requirements as recommended by the County Engineer:

## Minimum Requirements for Fiber Optic Construction

All Fiber optic line installations must have a permit.  
Permit must go through a Columbiana County Commissioner's Meeting.  
Should future construction or improvements by any Columbiana County entity or the underlying fee owner of the land require this utility to be relocated, it will be done at the expense of the utility owner.  
Should the installation extend beyond the existing public right of way the utility must obtain the necessary easements from the underlying fee owner.

## Aerial Installations Only

Must have permit.  
Must go through a Columbiana County Commissioner's Meeting.  
Any additional restrictions on the permit must be adhered to.

## Underground Installations

Must have permit.  
Must go through a Columbiana County Commissioner's Meeting.  
Plans must be signed by an Ohio P.E with a COA to work in Ohio.  
Plans must be signed by an Ohio P.S with a COA to work in Ohio.  
All underground lines must be a minimum of 48 inches deep.  
All road crossings must be a minimum of 60 inches below the road and accompanying ditch.  
All storm sewer crossing must be a minimum of 60 inches below the storm pipe.  
5-foot isolation distance out to out from any Sanitary sewer and Sanitary manholes.  
2-foot vertical separation from any Sanitary sewer.  
2-foot isolation distance out to out from any Storm Sewer.  
All utility crossings must have a 4-inch minimum over casing.  
Tracer wire must be installed on all underground lines.  
Line must be a minimum of 5 feet from edge of pavement or 2 feet beyond back of ditch, whichever is greater.  
Only flush mount hand holes and test stations will be permitted to be placed in Columbiana County right of way.  
The placement of hand holes and test stations will not be permitted to be placed in the ditch line, within 2 feet of any storm sewer trench or road culvert trench, within 2 feet of the outside wall of any catch basin, inlet or storm manhole.  
Any additional restrictions on the permit must be adhered to.
